Workshop Introduction: *At the heart of all forest management decisions is silviculture. Selecting the appropriate management regime requires analysis of numerous factors. The stand’s history and current conditions are vital to any decision. Consideration of the ecologic, economic, and philosophic goals of the landowner is also necessary. These factors must be weighed against potential sociological restrictions derived from the political pressure from both the local community and the state of California. As the management of forested landscapes has become increasingly political, the choice of silviculture has become front and center in the divisive discussion of how California forestlands should be managed.*
